	e)	20/04004/TR T3 Unknown - Remove. fell because majority of crown previously removed in apparent preservation of overhead telecommunications line (works undertaken prior to applicant's ownership) 54 Westgate Wetherby LS22 6NJ
	d)	20/03694/TR T1 Holly, T2 Cypress, T4 Cypress, T5 Holly - Remove. 2 The Beeches Wetherby LS22 6ST
	c)	20/03878/TR T1 Beech - A 4m reduction in height and spread of the crown should be undertaken. This would result in a top height of 16m being achieved and a lateral spread of 6.5m in all directions. Extensive crown weight reduction is required to reduce the potential of future failures of major limbs/stems at/around the site of the recent and historic failures. 1 Bridge End Boston Road Wetherby LS22 5HA
